COVID-19 has not gone away!!! – carry your vaccination certificate and a photo identity card with you



Please also now carry proof of your vaccinations when visiting a bar or restaurant whilst at a MACCC meeting or rally, either as a saved file on your phone or printed out on paper. Restaurants with a capacity of 50 or larger must legally scan the QR code on your vaccination certificate (passport) but any restaurant/bar can ask to do so if they so wish. El Campo has informed us that they will be scanning your certificate before allowing entry. These are the new rules. Please don't take it out on the restaurant or the club.

You should also carry a photo identity card; your TIE card, driving licence or passport, because this could be checked at the same time as scanning your certificate as proof that the certificate is yours.

So, Covid-19 has not gone away, and we would like to remind you to wear your facemask when walking between tables or going to the toilet or bar. Please respect the views of others and protect both yourself and your fellow members by following the Covid-19 restriction guidelines and wear your mask whenever you are not eating or drinking.

2022 Membership Renewal

It is now time to renew your membership for 2022. You must renew online, not at an Ace Café.

The club needs to maintain up-to-date information and annual renewal seems a good time to do it. Earlier in the year you were all kind enough to confirm your cars and now, especially, we need information about your emergency contact. This information is missing for a lot of members and, for other members, the contact is someone who is likely to be in the car on a rally with you and could, therefore, be involved in an accident with you. Obviously, the club needs details of someone that is unlikely to be in the car with you at that time. You should amass this information before logging in.

To renew, please follow these instructions :

- 1. Log into the Members Area using Username macccmembers and Password acecafe.
- 2. Select '2022 Membership Renewal' in the Member Area drop-down.
- 3. Log into the renewal process using your email address and your membership number.
- 4. The details we hold about you are presented in the form.
- 5. Check everything and over-key anything that needs updating.
- 6. When you're satisfied, press the 'Renew Membership' button. The form will not proceed if you have missed any of the mandatory information.
- 7. Now, take note of the club bank details and pay the renewal fee online directly into the club bank account.

Please pay online. The committee prefer not to accept cash payments.

The renewal period ends on 31st March 2022, after which you will need to reapply if you wish to rejoin. If you wish to vote at the 2022 AGM on Sunday 23rd January 2022 you will need to have renewed before then.

Please note, in accordance with current data protection practice, this is/will be the only personal data the club holds about you. We will no longer hold your home address or NIE/Passport number. If/when you attend one of the larger rallies (Spring Gallop and/or Annual Rally) where we have overnight stays in hotels, the organiser will ask for any required additional information at that time.

For those of you that have renewed, thank you, and you can now collect your 2022 membership card from the Merchandise table.
