# July Rally - Sunday 25<sup>th</sup> July 2021

This rally has a number of options of things to do along the way. We normally hold an evening rally in July but, if the weather's not too hot, go earlier in the day because there's plenty to do on this route.

#### You can:

- Climb up the side of the mountain (steps provided!) and have a look at the ancient wall art at Pla de Petracos (pictured),
- Take a bottle of water and walking shoes and have a walk to the Arcs de Castell de Castells,
- Stop off for a picnic at Área Recreativa Es Pou an excellent viewpoint with views out to the
  coast at Albir one stop off you shouldn't miss! but it's easy to drive past, so keep a look
  out it's poorly signposted,
- Have a look at the Jalon valley (Vall de Pop) from the viewpoint at Coll del Rates bring your binoculars! take care not to drive past as it's not easy to turn back.

The route takes you through Beniarbeig, Sagra, Vall d'Ebo, Petracos, Castell de Castells, Tarbena, Coll de Rates, Parcent, Alcalali, Llosa de Camacho, Pedreguer.

In accordance with current pandemic restrictions, the rally is to be conducted in a Covid-19-friendly manner. Sorry, as previously stated, the club cannot organise a group event but you can always make private arrangements with friends.

### **Result of the Car Audit**

Following the audit conducted over the last couple of months, the ratio within which the club operates can now be published more accurately. Members have registered a total of 177 classic and racing heritage cars. The split between classic and modern is 136 classic to 41 modern, giving a ratio of 3.32: 1. This is an acceptable ratio as we are required to operate no less than 3.00: 1.
