
Here is the latest news flash from the Marina Alta Classic Car Club.

Concours Day – 29th May 2022



After a two year break, due to the Covid-19 pandemic, we are extremely pleased to confirm that the MACCC Concours Day will go ahead as planned on Sunday 29th May 2022. The location will be as before, Denia Marina, and lunch will be at Restaurante Republic.

Those of you that would like to enter your cars in this event must let Richard Rihan (richard.rihan@marinaaltaccc.com) know by Tuesday 24th May 2022 at the latest. Entry fee for the concours is €5.00 per car. Whether you are entering your car or attending as a spectator, you also need to let us know your choice of menu by Tuesday 24th May 2022. If you are bringing guests you do need to tell us and also include their menu choice as well. The menu details attached and also on the website. The cost is 30€ per person including wine or beer, which represents a fantastic reduction on their normal price of 37.50€ excluding drinks.

There will not be a rally on this day.

Itinerary

Cars entered in the Concours must meet in the large car park to the left of the Marina access road no later than 11:30 (directions will be provided to those that enter). You will be lined up according to car category and drive in convoy to the harbour front in the Marina at 12:00. Judging will then commence. Lunch will be served at 14:00. The results and trophy presentations will take place after lunch, during coffee. Those of you not entering the Concours will need to park on the approach road or parking area at the back of the Marina. Parking in those areas is free.

The Concours

If this is your first Concours with the Club, don't panic! We will not be checking the cleanliness of your spark plugs! This is primarily a fun day out and judging will not be to the extremes found in some of the more serious events. Your car will be judged on overall presentation, with marks awarded for paintwork, chrome, glass, interior, wheels, tyres, engine bay, boot, spare wheel, tools, etc, (where appropriate). Consideration will be given to the age of the vehicle and, in the opinion of the judges, the amount of effort that has been put into the preparation. Spending money on a professional valet is not necessary. Tied scores will be decided on age of the car (not the owner!!).

We all know that there are many beautiful cars in our club and everyone will want theirs to be the winner but, unfortunately, there will only be three trophies, 1st, 2nd and 3rd, in each of Group A, B and C categories and only a 1st in Group D, so many of us may be disappointed! Please remember, the decisions of the judges will be final.
