# 2024 membership renewal - renewals is open

Membership runs from January to December every year. Members wishing to renew into 2024 must do so before the AGM, which is on 28th January 2024. Any member that joined the club near the end of the year, from 1st October, is automatically renewed free-of-charge. So, members with the membership number 483 or greater do not need to pay for 2024. All other members do.

Renewals are open from the 1st November to the AGM date, which is, approximately, a 3 month period. So, you can renew now. Please go to the Member Area, Make a Payment page and select 'Renew Membership'.
